


New book on Spiritual Healing

A new book, *Healing Chronic Illness: By His Spirit, Through His Resources*, proposes that God heals supernaturally, but our lack of realization of how much He loves us, among other roadblocks, keep us from experiencing His healing.

Written from the perspective of a medical writer who also struggles with chronic illness, the book offers unique insights into healing which include: how dysfunctional biochemistry and emotional trauma affect our ability to believe in a loving God who heals; why people who have faith for miracles aren't

always made well; why God sometimes chooses other healing methods besides a supernatural encounter to heal, and how we can better position ourselves to receive a miracle from Him.

Most current books on supernatural healing claim that it's God will to supernaturally heal, but don't mention the ways in which sickness can be redemptive, and how God can ultimately use our trials of illness to heal us. Also, they don't discuss the factors which affect our ability to believe in His love, and consequently, His desire to make us well. *Healing Chronic Illness: By His Spirit, Through His Resources*, addresses these, and offers helpful insights for people who struggle to receive from God, because of their suffering and traumatic life experiences.

Following is a chapter-by-chapter synopsis of the book:

- 1) This first chapter describes the author's healing journey and the factors that led her to pursue supernatural healing after becoming a professional medical researcher.
- 2) Despite God's promises of healing in the Bible, God sometimes allows illness. Thirteen reasons why are explained here. Most of these reasons are, ironically, to bring people to health; in body, mind and spirit.
- 3) Just as Chapter Two cites thirteen reasons why God may allow disease, this one cites thirteen reasons why God ultimately promises healing to all who seek Him. These are based on Biblical principles.
- 4) A few of the most common reasons why Christian critics dispute the commonality of miracles are cited here, along with reasons why these arguments aren't valid.
- 5) Factors that enable healing, as well as those that block people in their ability to receive from God, are discussed in this chapter.
- 6) Healing miracles are more common in underdeveloped nations, and this chapter explores some reasons why.

- 7) A lack of understanding of God's love blocks healing. This chapter offers suggestions for learning how to cultivate a personal relationship with God, in order to more easily experience His love.
- 8) The role of dysfunctional biochemistry and dark spiritual forces in healing is outlined in this section.
- 9) While God heals supernaturally, he also uses medicine to make people well. Here, effective strategies for healing chronic illness in the natural realm are mentioned.
- 10) This brief chapter discusses the appropriateness of taking medicine, while maintaining faith in God for healing.
- 11) This summary chapter proposes how to reconcile faith in God for a miracle when healing doesn't immediately, or always, manifest.

Appendix: A man named Terry Wilson has experienced many healing miracles throughout his life, and has been used by God to heal thousands of others. His experiences are described here.

Ms. Strasheim's research for *Healing Chronic Illness: By His Spirit, Through His Resources*, involved studying a multitude of books on healing, attending conferences and church services where supernatural healing is practiced, both locally and internationally, and attending Global Awakening's School of Healing and Impartation. Additionally, ten years of research in the area of mind-body medicine, as well as her relationship with God during the eight years that she has suffered from disabling chronic illness, have provided vital information for the book.
